NOTICE OF ERRATA TO ORDER 03

Re: *In the Matter of the Investigation to Consider the Effect of Inflation on the Cost of Greenhouse Gas Emissions*,
 Docket U-190730

TO ALL PARTIES:

On July 28, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Order 03, Adopting an Adjusted Cost of Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reflecting the Effect of Inflation (Order 03). In Order 03, Table 1, the right-hand column header incorrectly identifies a discount rate in 2019 dollars. The correct rate is calculated in 2021 dollars. The Commission hereby corrects Table 1 to read as follows:
