On April 1, 2021, Puget Sound Energy (PSE), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a draft 2021 All-Source Request for Proposals for Renewable and Peak Capacity Resources (Draft 2021 All-Source RFP) for approval by the Commission, as required by Order 05 under Docket UE-200413 and as specified in WAC Chapter 480-107.
