## TO ALL PARTIES:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) initiated a special proceeding in the above-referenced docket to determine if Jumpin' Joey's d/b/a Lymelight Party Bus (Jumpin' Joey's or Company) is engaged in business as a charter party or excursion company without possessing the required authority from the Commission to conduct such operations.

On August 30, 2022, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; and Notice of Virtual Hearing set for September 30, 2022, at 2 p.m.

The Commission convened the hearing as scheduled on September 30, 2022. Counsel for the Company appeared by telephone and explained that he was recently retained and has not yet had time to prepare testimony and evidence to demonstrate that the Company's operations are not subject to Commission jurisdiction. The presiding officer agreed to continue this matter to a later date to allow the Company's counsel sufficient time to prepare his case. The presiding officer also requested the Company and its attorney ensure they are prepared to appear at the rescheduled hearing via video conferencing on Zoom.

The Commission finds good cause to continue the special proceeding to **Friday, October 14**, **2022, at 10 a.m.** The parties should ensure they are able to appear for the virtual hearing via video conferencing on Zoom.
