Re: AMENDED Review Committee Decision – Complaint Cases 23-093 and 23-099 M&L Construction vs. Avista Corporation

Dear Ms. Hunter:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee (committee) received complaints filed by M&L Construction against Avista Corporation (Avista) regarding potential violations of the Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030.

On Nov. 14, 2023, the committee formed a peer review board and reviewed Complaint Cases 23-093 and 23-099.

Regarding Case 23-093, the peer review board determined that the respondent, Avista, violated RCW 19.122.030(4)(a) one time, for not providing information to the excavator within two business days.

Regarding Case 23-099, the peer review board determined that the respondent, Avista, violated RCW 19.122.030(3)(a) one time for failing to accurately locate the company's electric service and recommends a \$5,000 penalty assessment.

Therefore, the committee recommends a total penalty of \$10,000 be assessed to the respondent as follows:

- \$5,000 for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(4)(a) that occurred on Sept. 11, 2023, at 8110 N Panorama Dr, Spokane, WA
- 5,000 for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(3)(a) that occurred on Sept. 26, 2023, at 7811 N. Panorama Dr, Spokane, WA
