- 1 The Administrative Law Judge entered Order 04 in this matter on January 10, 2007. The suspension period for the proposed tariff under review permits it to become effective on February 1, 2007, in the absence of prior contrary action by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission).
  
- 2 The Commission sets the following schedule for review of the initial order prior to the effective date of the tariff.<sup>1</sup>

**Petitions for administrative review** must be filed by 2:00 p.m. on Monday, January 22, 2007.

**Answers** to petitions for administrative review must be filed by 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 24, 2007.

- 3 In addition, the Commission may review the Initial Order on its own motion if no party seeks administrative review. The review will be conducted under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-825(8). Parties may file petitions for administrative review or statements of position on any matters addressed in the order. Without limiting its review, the Commission will accept statements of position on the following questions without limiting parties' review: If an order rejects a tariff proposal because the evidence fails to support the full rates requested, and an

opponent opposes any rate increase at all, when, if ever, should the order identify a level that the presiding officer believes is supported by the evidence? Does the record support the need for contributions in aid of construction in lieu of rate base recognition of the asset after completion?

- 4 Petitions for administrative review and statements of position will be considered timely if filed by January 22, 2007. Answers will be timely if filed by January 24, 2007.
