1. APPLICABILITY:

This Deferred Tax Receivable Tracker rate shall apply to all bills for Electric Service to Customers of the Company and will be applied to all bills to Customers with Energy usage during a month when this schedule is effective.

2. DEFINITIONS:

- a. Tax Benefit: are amounts passed through to Customers in the form of lower current rates for Electric Service but that the Company has not actually realized through its federal tax return.
- b. Cost of Tax Benefit: is the cost that the Company incurs due to the pass-through of Tax Benefits to Customers until such time that the Company realizes the benefit on its federal tax return.

3. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this schedule is to collect the Cost of Tax Benefit on Tax Benefits included in Customer rates that the Company has not yet received on its tax return. The amount removed from general rates and used to set rates through this tracker is \$_____.

4. RATE CHANGES:

The Company will request reductions in the rates shown in this schedule following any tax-year-end between general rate cases where the Company has received the tax benefit on its tax return.

The Company will request increases in the rates shown in this schedule following any tax-year-end between general rates cases where the Company's Cost of Tax Benefit changes relative to the Tax Benefit provided to Customers. This will be limited to new assets included in the most recent regulatory filing that had a future tax benefit included in their cost recovery.

The rates in this schedule will be reset in general rate proceeding based on the timing of Tax Benefits included in rates and when the Company actually receives the future benefit.

5. MONTHLY RATE:

The charges or credits shown in this schedule apply to the rate schedules identified on the following sheets and at the charge shown for the applicable rate schedule.
