Starlink Services, LLC (“Starlink”) hereby informs the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission (“Commission”) that it is not required to file the Federal Communications Commission’s Form 481 by July 29, 2022, because Starlink has not yet been authorized to receive Rural Digital Opportunity Fund (“RDOF”) high-cost Universal Service Fund support. Starlink did not receive any high-cost support in 2021, nor has it been issued a Study Area Code for Washington. Starlink anticipates receiving authorization for RDOF and respectfully requests the Commission recertify Starlink as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier for receipt of federal high-cost funds.
