In 2019, PSP incurred a total of \$507,806.45 in transportation expenses. As a result of the pilot transportation study that was conducted over three months of 2019, PSP underwent a significant change in how transportation expenses were treated. Historically, Transportation Expense Charges ("TEC") that are included in the current BPC tariff have been paid to the pilot who performed the vessel assignment to reimburse that pilot's individual transportation expense. Thus, individual pilot's transportation expense for TEC assignments was not historically included in PSP's expense. However, PSP historically did incur expense for repositioning pilots between the Port Angeles Pilot Station and assignments. During the transportation trial, all TEC revenue was paid to PSP rather than to pilots, and all transportation expense was incurred or reimbursed by PSP. Thus, the totals for 2019 reflect a change in practices rendering the comparison to prior years an apples-to-oranges scenario.
