intermodal containers mounted on over the road chassis that are transported for transfer to a
 railroad for final delivery of the intermodal containers to the landfill in Oregon.

4. Previously, PTP contracted with Murrey's Disposal Co., Inc. dba Waste
 Connections ("Murrey's") to collect PTP's OCC Rejects. Murrey's did not have enough
 equipment to handle PTP's volume. Consequently, PTP was forced to dump the OCC Rejects on
 the ground and then later to load the OCC Rejects when Murrey's could provide a container.
 This cost PTP twice as much to handle and PTP did not want this solid waste left waiting on the
 ground.

 PTP experienced other problems with Murrey's OCC Rejects service which cost

 PTP more.

6. WMW has done a phenomenal job collecting PTP's OCC Rejects and ensuring
that we have the necessary intramodal containers and pickup necessary to service PTP's heavy
volume of OCC Rejects.

14 7. If WMW's intermodal service of PTP's OCC Rejects was stopped immediately, it
15 would cause substantial injury and risks to PTP. From our past experience, we do not believe
16 that Murrey's could provide the necessary service and certainly not immediately.
