Dear Mr. Johnson:

Pursuant to the Utilities and Transportation Commission's ("Commission") Order 04 dated October 2, 2019, Public Counsel provides a list of contested issues contained in testimony addressing Avista's Energy Recovery Mechanism (ERM) filing. Public Counsel addresses two issues in our testimony.

Public Counsel's testimony will address the prudence of incremental power costs incurred by Avista resulting from the 2018 compliance-related outage at the Colstrip coal-fired electric generation plant. Our witness concludes that the outage was imprudent, and Public Counsel will recommend that increased power costs resulting from the outage be disallowed. Public Counsel anticipates that this issue will be contested.

Public Counsel will also provide an update regarding the power cost workshop the Commission ordered in Avista's last rate case to address the directional bias of the Company's power cost calculations.¹ Our witness identifies a major source of bias and concludes that the Commission should re-affirm its ruling that Avista's power cost calculations are directionally biased, continue to support the stakeholder workshop process, and require Avista to correct identified errors and biases in its power cost calculations by its next rate case. Public Counsel believes this issue will be largely uncontested because we are not asking the Commission to correct the bias in this case,
