ERRATA TO COMMISSION STAFF'S PETITION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW OF THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Commission Staff has noted an error in its Petition for Review filed in this matter at page 11, second full paragraph, third sentence. None of the accompanying appendices or calculations have changed, but the description of what they demonstrate is more clearly set out in the following revised sentence:

Allowing the Company to include the Navigator in rate base at the level it proposes the Order proposes adds the amount of \$12,223\$25,409 to rate base and includes approximately \$5,241\$3,300 of annually in depreciation expense above the surrogate proposed by Staff. (Appendix 1, page 7).

I apologize for not noting this error sooner, but hope that this clarification will assist the Commission in its review of the Initial Order in this case.
