I do not support an exception to the "no coal" rule, as implemented by the executive attestation "has reviewed all e-tag data for the prior calendar year and found no electricity from coal-fired resources was included in market purchases and therefore no such electricity was included in retail customer rates."

However, if UTC does choose to allow such an exception for trading hubs such as Mid-C, I would ask:

- 1) That the exception only be temporary in nature in order to allow for the development of "No Coal" trading markets.
- 2) That utilities have to publicly report yearly how much coal power they have purchased through trading hubs, so that the nature and extent of this "Coal Leakage" can be publicly recognized and considered.
