Ms. Crane states that “Mr. Piliaris also filed Supplemental Testimony, stating the electric revenue requirement would increase by approximately \$70,000 due to the reclassification of one customer to rate Schedule 40.” Please provide a citation to where in the testimony of Mr. Piliaris it states that PSE’s electric revenue requirement would increase as a result of reclassifying any customer to Schedule 40.

RESPONSE:

Ms. Crane’s testimony should have stated that the “electric revenue deficiency would increase by approximately \$70,000...”, as noted on page 3, lines 11-13 of Mr. Piliaris’s Supplemental Testimony. Ms. Crane will make this correction during the hearings in this case.
