**BACKGROUND**

- 1 On September 23, 2002, the Commission entered its Thirty-Ninth Supplemental Order in this proceeding clarifying Verizon’s obligation to make a compliance in accordance with the Thirty-Second and Thirty-Eighth Supplemental Orders in this docket. The Order directed Verizon to submit compliance filings no later than eight calendar weeks after service of the order.
- 2 Verizon, on November 18, 2002 filed Advice No. 3061 containing tariff revisions for its Tariff Nos. WN U-18 Network Interconnection Access Service.
