On April 29, 2011 CenturyLink filed revisions to the United Telephone Company of the Northwest Washington Access Tariff (WN U-10) in compliance with Order 14 in Docket No. UT-100820. This filing generally reduces the intrastate switched access rates for United Telephone Company of the Northwest to mirror the intrastate switched access rates and rate structure of the Qwest ILEC tariff (WN U-44) in the state of Washington. However, there are limited instances where an individual rate element reflects an increase from its current level in order to comply with the Commission's order requiring a mirroring of the Qwest intrastate switched access rates and rate structure. Please refer to CenturyLink's tariff filing for the specific rate changes associated with this filing.

In accordance with the provisions of Order 14 in Docket No. UT-100820, the proposed effective date of these changes is May 29, 2011.
