- 1 On January 29, 2003, the Commission entered its Complaint and Order in this docket suspending tariff revisions. In doing so, it ordered that the existing tariff, the Company's Tariff Schedule No. 163 in Tariff WN U-29, be extended for one year, to expire on January 29, 2004. As the suspended tariff was filed for effect on April 1, 2003, the statutory suspension period ends on January 31, 2004.

- 2 The Company has waived the suspension period for two weeks, by letter from its counsel David Meyer on January 27, 2004. Consequently, the suspension period now ends on February 14, 2004 and it is necessary to extend the current Tariff Sheet No. 163 so that it will continue in effect through the end of the suspension period.

ORDER

- 3 THE COMMISSION ORDERS that the expiration of Avista's existing Tariff Schedule No. 163 is extended until February 14, 2004.
