**NOTICE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING CERTAIN
FILING REQUIREMENTS
(until May 18, 2020)**

RE: *Wash. Utils. & Transp. Comm'n v. PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Co.*
Dockets UE-191024 *et. al.*

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS AND PARTIES:

On December 13, 2019, PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective tariff, WN U-75 for Electric Service, designed to effect an increase in revenues of \$3.1 million from its Washington operations, offset by amortization of remaining deferred tax benefits associated with the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of approximately \$7.1 million, resulting in an overall rate reduction of \$4 million, or approximately 1.1 percent.

On January 9, 2020, the Commission suspended operation of the tariff revisions by issuing Order 01, Complaint and Order Suspending Tariff Revisions.

The Commission held a Prehearing Conference on January 31, 2020.

On February 3, 2020, the Commission issued Order 03/01/06 consolidating Dockets UE-191024, UE-190750, UE-190929, UE-190981, and UE-180778 and, among other things, requiring the filing of an original and three (3) paper copies of all unredacted documents filed with the Commission.

Due to present circumstances regarding COVID-19, the Commission finds good cause to modify the requirements requiring the filing of an original and three (3) paper copies of all unredacted documents filed with the Commission. Accordingly, the requirement to file paper

copies of documents in Dockets UE-191024 *et. al.* will be suspended for two months and may be reevaluated thereafter.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the requirement to file an original and three (3) paper copies of all unredacted documents filed with the Commission in Dockets UE-191024 *et. al.*, is suspended until May 18, 2020.
