MOTION TO LIFT SUSPENSION AND
APPROVE SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT

20 1. In accordance with the Notice Suspending Procedural Schedule issued on August 16, 2012,
21 Waste Management of Washington, Inc. and the Staff of the Washington Utilities and
22 Transportation Commission hereby submit a Settlement Agreement on behalf of all parties.
23 Pursuant to WAC 480-07-740 and WAC 480-07-750, the parties jointly move for an order
24 approving the Settlement Agreement as a full settlement of all issues in both pending
25 consolidated dockets. The parties further move that the Commission lift the suspensions
26 ordered by the Commission in each of the consolidated dockets.


1 2. This motion is accompanied by a Settlement Agreement and a Narrative Supporting
2 Settlement Agreement, as required by WAC 480-07-740(2)(a). All parties have signed both
3 documents. The parties suggest the documents provide the Commission with sufficient
4 information to reach a decision, and that a hearing to consider the proposed settlement is not
5 necessary under WAC 480-07-740(1)(d). If the Commission deems a hearing to be necessary,
6 the parties will provide witnesses to testify in support of the proposal and answer questions
7 concerning the settlement's details, and its costs and benefits, and counsel for the parties
8 would make themselves available to respond to questions from the bench regarding those
9 subjects under WAC 480-07-740(b).
