TO ALL PARTIES:

On June 1, 2017, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power or Company) submitted to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) its 2016 Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism (PCAM) filing for approval. On October 2, 2017, both Commission staff and Boise White Paper, L.L.C. submitted letters to the Commission requesting that the matter be set for adjudicative proceeding.

On October 5, 2018, the Commission issued a Notice of Prehearing Conference, which established Administrative Law Judge Gregory J. Kopta as the presiding officer, and the prehearing conference was held on October 23.

On October 26, 2018, the Commission entered Order 01, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 01), which set the matter for hearing on April 4, 2018, and, among other things, established the requirements for filing of documents. Specifically, paragraph 9 of Order 01 required parties to file electronic copies of documents only.

The Commissioners will now be presiding over this adjudication with Judge Kopta. At the Commissioner's request, going forward parties must also file an **original and 3** paper copies (with original signatures, if applicable) of all documents with the Commission by 5 p.m. on the next business day following the filing deadline established in the procedural schedule (or other deadline as applicable) unless the Commission orders otherwise.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the Commissioners of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission and Administrative Law Judge Gregory J. Kopta will preside during this proceeding.
