4 **Q. Please state your name and business address.**

5 A. My name is Robert S. Stolarski. My business address is 355 110<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE,  
6 P.O. Box 97034, Bellevue, WA 98009-9734.

7 **Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?**

8 A. I am employed by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. ("PSE") as Director, Customer  
9 Energy Management.

10 **Q. What are your duties as Director, Customer Energy Management?**

11 A. As the Director of Customer Energy Management I am responsible for and lead  
12 the development, implementation and evaluation of PSE's portfolio of energy  
13 efficiency programs.

14 **Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.**

15 A. I graduated from Southern Methodist University with a Bachelor of Science  
16 degree in Mechanical Engineering and I am registered in the State of Washington  
17 as a Professional Engineer.

1 I have over 30 years of experience in the energy management industry, with  
2 extensive experience in energy efficiency program planning, development and  
3 implementation. From 1980-1994 I worked as an energy management engineer  
4 and project manager responsible for developing and delivering energy efficiency  
5 projects. This role included project identification, savings and feasibility  
6 analysis, installation design criteria development, utility financing coordination  
7 and final inspection and acceptance of increasing complex projects for all types of  
8 non-residential facilities.

9 From 1994-2002 I was the manager of various groups responsible for providing  
10 extraordinary customer service to and initiate innovative projects with large  
11 commercial and industrial sites. This included development and operation of a  
12 Basic Ordering Agreement with local Navy facilities to build energy efficiency  
13 projects and a partnership with Enron Energy Service implementing shared  
14 savings projects through the DOE Super ESPC for the Western U.S. Region.

15 From 2002-2007 I was the Manager of Business Energy Management and led the  
16 group responsible for all aspects of efficiency programs for the non-residential  
17 market.

18 In 2007 I became Director of the teams responsible for the delivery of electric and  
19 natural gas energy efficiency programs, and I am also responsible for the program  
20 planning, development and the follow-up evaluation of these programs. The  
21 annual budgets for this portfolio programs for all customer markets is over \$100  
22 million.
