Dear Ms. Washburn:

In compliance with WAC 480-120-034, Comcast Phone of Washington, LLC ("Comcast") is notifying the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("WUTC") of a change in Comcast's classification from a Class A company to a Class B company. On July 12, 2005 the WUTC published on its website the 2% threshold access lines served in Washington as of December 31, 2004. The new definition of a Class B company is a company serving 76,493 access lines or less. Comcast currently serves less than 76,493 access lines.

As a result Comcast will no longer provide monthly service quality reports to the WUTC. Should Comcast exceed the threshold in the future, the WUTC will be notified of the fact and Comcast will resume reporting.
