**NOTICE OF PUGET SOUND ENERGY

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On July 29, 2005, Puget Sound Energy (PSE) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), pursuant to WAC 480-107, its draft Request for Proposals (RFP). This provision provides for a 90-day period of Commission review and public comment.

PSE has identified a significant energy and capacity need for the period 2006 – 2015. The Company asserts that its needs grow from 233 average megawatts and approximately 1,000 megawatts in the winter of 2006/2007, to 1,591 average megawatts and approximately 1,600 megawatts by 2015. PSE also seeks bids on programmatic conservation and estimates a reduction in energy need by approximately 279 average megawatts by 2015.

The Commission seeks comments from interested persons on PSE's RFP. Written comment should be filed with the Commission, bearing the above caption and docket number, not later than September 28, 2005.
