1 On May 17, 2012, Ivan Ingram d/b/a AA Eagle Relocation Service (Ivan Ingram) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application for authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 81.80 and Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15.

2 On September 26, 2012, the Commission issued a notice of its intention to deny Ivan Ingram’s application for permanent authority due to a significant misrepresentation with respect to Mr. Ingram’s criminal history. The notice provided Mr. Ingram an opportunity to request a hearing to contest the factual allegations if he filed a written request with the Commission by October 10, 2012.

3 On October 4, 2012, Ivan Ingram filed with the Commission a request for hearing. Mr. Ingram did not provide a specific reason or note which of the Commission’s allegations he wished to contest.

4 Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482, WAC 480-15-330, and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether Ivan Ingram’s application for permanent authority should be denied due to the concerns raised after Staff’s review and investigation of the application.

5 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on Thursday, November 8, 2012, in Room 206, Second Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.**

- 6 The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.
- 7 Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- 8 In order to allow the Commission to better prepare for the adjudication, the Applicant is directed to file a short statement with the Commission **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 24, 2012**, explaining which of the Commission's allegations he wishes to dispute and the reasons for each challenge. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and – 145.
- 9 Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 1, 2012**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and – 145.
- 10 **THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.**
