RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. UW-120865

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 13, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Green Mountain H2O in the amount of \$ 2,100 for violation of WAC 480-110-505, which requires water companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. The Commission sent Green Mountain H2O a Second Notice on August 15, 2012, and a Final Notice on September 19, 2012. On October 18, 2012, the company filed a letter requesting that the penalty be waived. On December 4, 2012, the Commission issued Order 01: Order Partially Suspending Penalty, Subject to Condition, suspending \$600 of the penalty amount leaving a balance of \$1,500 due and owing within 30 days.

The Commission has not received the \$1,500 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$1,500 balance.
