B. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement sets out the terms and conditions by which grants are made from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund. These grants are administered by the UTC to the grantee for Docket No. TR-130500, identified above.

C. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

TR-130500 involves installing solar-powered advance warning signs with constant flashing LED blinkers on both approaches to the railroad crossing on South Track Road. The crossing is identified as USDOT 104518X.

D. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The project reimbursement period shall begin on November 15, 2013, and end June 1, 2014. No expenditure made before or after this period is eligible for reimbursement unless incorporated by written amendment into this agreement.

E. PROJECT FUNDING

Total grant funding awarded by the UTC for this project shall not exceed \$19,932.84. The total approximate cost of the project is \$19,932.84. The grantee shall be responsible for all additional costs.

F. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

All rights and obligations of the parties to this agreement are subject to this agreement and its attachments, including the grantee's application, Commission orders, and the general provisions, all of which are attached and incorporated into this agreement.

Except as provided, no alteration of any of the terms or conditions of this agreement will be effective unless provided in writing. All alterations must be signed by both parties.

The grantee has read, fully understands and agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions in these documents.

G.
