in the amount of \$1,500	ORDER GRANTING PAYMENT ARRANGEMENT

BACKGROUND

- 1 On February 8, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$1,500 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against Big Woody Limos, LLC (Big Woody Limos or Company) for 10 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-30-221, which adopts by reference 49 C.F.R. Part 382 related to drug and alcohol testing; Part 391 related to driver qualifications; and Part 395 related to driver hours of service.
- 2 On March 14, 2017, Big Woody Limos responded to the Penalty Assessment admitting the violations and requesting mitigation of the penalty.
- 3 On March 27, 2017, the Commission issued Order 01 Denying Mitigation. Order 01 directed the Company to either pay the penalty or file jointly with Staff a proposed payment arrangement by April 7, 2017.
- 4 On April 20, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) contacted the Executive Director and Secretary of the Commission explaining that the Company requested to pay the penalty in installments, and that Staff supports the request. The Company and Staff jointly propose the following payment schedule:

May 5, 2017	\$150
June 5, 2017	\$150
July 5, 2017	\$150
August 7, 2017	\$150
September 5, 2017	\$150
October 5, 2017	\$150
November 6, 2017	\$150
December 5, 2017	\$150
January 5, 2018	\$150
February 5, 2018	\$150

5 Staff also proposed that if Big Woody Limos misses one payment, the entire balance will become due and payable immediately.

DISCUSSION

6 The installment payment schedule Staff and the Company propose is reasonable. The Commission approves the proposal with one modification. If Big Woody Limos fails to pay the penalty by the date it becomes due in full – either immediately upon a missed installment, or February 5, 2018, whichever applies – the Commission may cancel the Company’s charter and excursion carrier certificate.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 7 (1) The \$1,500 penalty is due and payable to the Commission in installments as set out in paragraph 4, above.
- 8 (2) If Big Woody Limos, LLC fails to pay any installment by 5 p.m. on the date it is due, the unpaid balance will immediately become due and payable without further order by the Commission.
- 9 (3) If Big Woody Limos, LLC fails to pay any portion of the assessed penalty by the due date, the Commission may cancel the Company’s charter and excursion carrier certificate by order in this docket.
