RE: Order 01, Granting Accounting Petition Authorizing Return on a Deferred Asset at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Rate

Docket TG-170977 - Petition for Accounting Treatment Order

Dear Mr. King:

Commission Staff has reviewed the compliance filing of Basin Disposal, Inc. (BDI or company) dated February 27, 2018, consisting of Tariff Supplement No. 2 and cover letter, in response to Order 01 issued January 26, 2018, in docket TG-170977. The company was ordered to: (1) apply the FERC rate to the PLP deferred asset; (2) file tariff revisions reflecting the rate impact by April 1, 2018; (3) file tariff revisions that reflect an update of the average investment and incorporate changes to the FERC rate, to be effective every January 1st.

On February 27, 2018, BDI, submitted a filing revising its Tariff 94 adding Tariff Supplement No. 2 reflecting the effect of the FERC rate applied to the average investment of the PLP deferred asset, with an effective date of April 1, 2018.

Staff believes that the filing complies fully with the Commission's Order 01, entered January 26, 2018.
