SUBJECT: Request for time extension for Dockets TR-171059, TR-171060, and TR-171061

Yakima County is requesting an extension of time to submit reimbursement requests for Dockets TR-171059, 171060, and 171061. The current orders stipulate that these projects must be completed no later than June 15, 2018. We are requesting that the completion date for each project be extended to July 31, 2018.

Plans and specifications for these projects were prepared and were advertised in March 2018 and bids were opened on March 28, 2018. The contract was awarded in April 10, 2018 and the successful contractor received approval of the materials and placed an order for the LED lights April 13, 2018. The contractor did not receive the LED lights from the supplier until June 6, 2018 and the lights were installed on June 7, 2018.

Yakima County will not be able to process the paper work to pay the contractor until June 29, 2018 and therefore will not be able to submit the reimbursement documents by the required deadline. We are requesting that the completion date for these projects be extended to July 31, 2018.
