RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Taylor's Excavators, Inc. in the Amount of \$1,000 for Violation of RCW 19.122.030(2), Docket DG-180218

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 16, 2018, the Commission issued a penalty assessment against Taylor's Excavators, Inc. (Taylor's Excavators or Company) for one violation of RCW 19.122. In the penalty assessment, the Commission offered to suspend and ultimately waive the penalty on the conditions that Taylor's Excavators employees attend Dig Safe training provided by the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the penalty assessment, and that Taylor's Excavators commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 during those 12 months.

On March 22, 2018, Taylor's Excavators filed a response to the penalty assessment, accepting the conditions offered.

On April 22, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Taylor's Excavators has not attended NUCA Dig Safe training, and recommending the Commission impose the \$1,000 suspended penalty.

On April 30, 2019, Taylor's Excavators paid the \$1,000 penalty.

This Commission closes this docket.
