RE: Commission Staff's Letter Confirming Compliance
D-190113 – Andrews Landshapers (601-634-671) – Investigation #7959

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Commission staff has reviewed the compliance order for Andrews Landshapers (Company) dated April 16, 2019. Compliance with the order required the following items be met:

- \$1,000 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122.030(2), which occurred on November 13, 2018, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$800 of the \$1,000 penalty amount if the owner of Andrews Landshapers attend Dig Safe Training within 12 months of the penalty assessment, and incur no additional dig law violations within 12 months.

On May 20, 2019, the Company notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions, and made a payment of \$200. On April 17, 2019, the Company provided documentation to the Commission that it completed Dig Safe Training on April 16, 2019. Andrews Landshapers has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes that Andrews Landshapers has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance action under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$800 penalty amount and close this docket.
