6	JUDGE DOYLE: All right. Good afternoon.
7	Let's be on the record in Docket TV-191046.
8	It's 1:30 p.m. on February 27th, 2020, which
9	is the time set for hearing the Commission's complaint
LO	against 19 household goods carriers seeking to cancel
L1	their permits for failure to file their annual reports
L2	and pay their regulatory fees.
L3	My name is Samantha Doyle. I'm the
L4	administrative law judge presiding over this proceeding.
L5	Seated to my left is Administrative Law Judge Rayne
L6	Pearson who is co-presiding with me today.
L7	Let's start by taking an appearance with
L8	Commission Staff.
L9	MR. ROBERSON: Good afternoon, Judge Doyle.
20	My name is Jeff Roberson, R-o-b-e-r-so-n. I'm an
21	assistant attorney general who represents Commission
22	Staff, and seated with me at counsel table is Ms. Rachel
23	Stark who is Staff's witness in this case.
24	JUDGE DOYLE: Staff has provided a list of
25	seven companies that have come into compliance since the

1	complaints were served. As such, Staff will move to
2	dismiss the complaints against the following companies:
3	Alaska Coast Transport, Incorporated;
4	American Moving Company, Incorporated; Backbreakers NW,
5	LLL; Callbox Storage, LLC; Five Stars Delivery LLC; PNW
6	Moving & Delivery LLC; Stanley G. Alexander,
7	Incorporated; and was there any updates to this list,
8	Mr. Roberson?
9	MR. ROBERSON: Just one, which is that
10	Friends and Family Moving and Storage, Incorporated has
11	filed its annual report, they previously paid their
12	regulatory fees, which means technically they're in
13	compliance, although they have not paid their late fee
14	or the interest associated with that. They have
15	requested that they be allowed to do that tomorrow, and
16	Staff is not opposed to that request.
17	JUDGE DOYLE: Okay. We can grant them the
18	close of business tomorrow, that would be
19	February 28th, 2020, to to pay that interest and late
20	fees.
21	We have also been oh, and thank you, and
22	I'll grant the motion to dismiss those seven company
23	or seven companies named with the addition of the
24	Friends and Family Moving and Storage subject to hearing
25	from Ms. Stark that they paid their interest and late

Tees.
There have also been a number of companies
whose permits were cancelled in the other dockets for
unrelated reasons prior to today's hearing. Those
companies are A-1 Piano Sales and Rentals, Incorporated;
Arays Moving Service, LLC; Jason M. Nelson; Pacific King
Relocation and Logistics Systems LLC.
Now, I'll also go through the list the
rest of the companies named in the complaint to see if
any of them are here or appearing on the bridge line
today. Because there is a court reporter creating a
record of today's proceeding, please give a verbal
response to the roll call like "here" or "present" in
addition to raising your hand when I call your company's
name.
Let's start with JFS Transport,
Incorporated?
John Volken Academy?
Johnson's Moving LLC?
Al Alberto Moreno Mendoza?
Property Pros Exterior Solutions LLC?
Redefyne Moving LLC?
We Like to Move It, Move It!! LLC?
All right. Hearing nothing, we can proceed.
Mr. Roberson, would you go ahead when you're

1 ready?

MR. ROBERSON: Certainly, Your Honor. I guess at this point, Staff would move to hold all of the companies that you just named in default under RCW 34.05.448 and WAC 480-07-450 for failure to appear at the time and place set for hearing. Under both the APA and the Commission's rule, the Commission can dispose of the substantive issues without the benefit of a hearing for those parties.

Ms. Stark is here to provide an evidentiary basis on which the Commission can issue a dispositive order. And so Staff would call Ms. Stark assuming you grant that motion, I guess.

JUDGE DOYLE: Yes, we will go ahead and hold the -- the following companies will be held in default:

JFS Transport, Incorporated; John Volken Academy;

Johnson's Moving LLC; Alberto Moreno Mendoza; Property

Pros Exterior Solutions LLC; Redefyne Moving LLC; We

Like to Move It, Move It!! LLC. Those companies have not come into compliance and have also not made an appearance today, so they will be held in default.

The motion is granted and I'll now swear in Ms. Stark so that you can testify.

JUDGE DOYLE: Thank you.

And have you received any training to allow you 16 to carry out your duties as a regulatory analyst? 17 A. Yes. 18 Q. Okay. Are you familiar with the statutes and 19 rules governing the filing of annual reports and the 20 paying of regulatory fees? 21 A. Yes. 22 Q. And do statutes and rules require companies to

A. Yes.

Q. Could you explain the process for a company filing its annual report?

A. Okay. So in March of every year, the Commission will notify each regulated company that the annual report is ready for download on the Commission's website, and it's the company's responsibility to ensure that we have accurate and current contact information.

The companies then download the information, and by May 1st of each year, the company's required to file a complete and accurate annual report and pay regulatory fees. And then we analyze the report to make sure they -- they are complete, and we contact the company to -- for any abnormalities.

Q. Okay. And what is the process for paying regulatory fees?

A. I work with financial services office, and we -if a company pays the regulatory fees online, that
payment goes directly to financial services. And we
work in concert to make sure that the company is
provided the credit to their account to make sure that
they pay the correct amount and if they've paid late,
then ensuring that they've paid any late fees or
interest.

Does the Commission maintain a searchable database that allows you to determine whether or not a company has paid regulatory fees and filed its annual report?

A. Yes.

Q. And how does that process work?

A. We maintain a list what's -- it's on our program called the Annual Reporting Tracking System or ARTS for short, and so each company's record is entered into ARTS so that we can keep a record of when they filed, all the company information is in there, how much regulatory fees are due, and anytime there's contact with the company via phone, we document that information. If we've sent them letters, we also document that in ARTS so that there's a complete record of the process for them.

- Q. And have you gone through that process with each of the companies listed in the complaint?
 - A. Yes.
- Q. And do you know when the last time you looked for each of these companies in terms of whether or not they filed or paid?
 - A. Yes. Actually, three days ago.
 - Q. Okay. Did John Volken Academy file an annual

Did Alberto Moreno Mendoza file an annual report 7 or pay regulatory fees last year? 8 A. No. 9 Q. Did Property Pros Exterior Solutions file an 10 annual report or pay regulatory fees last year? 11 A. No. 12 Q. Did Redefyne Moving LLC file an annual report or 13 pay regulatory fees last year? 14 A. No. 15 Q. Did We Like to Move It, Move It!! file an annual 16 report or pay regulatory fees last year? 17 A. No. 18 MR. ROBERSON: Staff is pretty much done, 19 Your Honor. 20 JUDGE DOYLE: And just for the -- my 21 clarification, did JFS Transport, Incorporated pay their 22 regulatory fees last year? 23 MR. ROBERSON: Oh. 24 MS. STARK: No, they did not. 25 JUDGE DOYLE: Thank you.

1	Okay. And then, Mr. Roberson, would you
2	like to make a closing statement or summarize
3	Ms. Stark's statements?
4	MR. ROBERSON: Sure. I believe it's under
5	WAC 480-15-451 and WAC 480-15-302(1), the Commission is
6	authorized to cancel the household goods carrier permits
7	of companies that fail to file annual reports or pay
8	their regulatory fees. The remaining companies listed,
9	which would be as you just noted, JSF Moving, John
10	Volken Academy, Johnson's Moving LLC, Alberto Moreno
11	Mendoza, Property Pros Exterior Solutions LLC, Redefyne
12	Moving LLC, and We Like to Move It, Move It!! all failed
13	to file their annual reports and pay regulatory fees.
14	Staff requests that the Commission cancel their
15	household goods carrier permits.
16	JUDGE DOYLE: I will issue an initial order
17	in this docket reflecting that the seven companies
18	previously named were held in default today for failing
19	to appear. The record supports not only holding these
20	companies in default, but also canceling their household
21	goods permits.
22	The seven companies having come into
23	compliance will have the complaints against them
24	dismissed, and I will include Friends and Family Moving
25	subject to their payment of fees and interest by
