**RE: Notice of Possible Collection Action, Penalty Assessment Invoice No. 5998**

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on July 28, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Vasiliys Construction Plus, LLC in the amount of \$6,000 for violations of RCW 19.122.030(2), failing to request a dig ticket prior to excavating. Payment was due by August 15, 2020.

The Commission sent you a Final Notice dated November 25, 2020, indicating that the balance of \$6,000 was due. To date, the Commission has not received payment of the balance due.

**This is to notify you that the Commission may forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. In that event,** you likely would incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest, which would be added to your outstanding \$6,000 balance.
