## RATE INCREASE NOTICE FOR COMPACTOR GARBAGE

Dear Customer:

May 1, 2020

Island Disposal Company, Inc. has filed a request for a rate increase with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC). The last general rate increase was approved by the WUTC July 2, 2012. Since that time, the Company has experienced higher costs for employee wages, benefits, fuel, truck equipment and has purchased additional capital assets.

If approved by the WUTC, the proposed rates below will become effective June 1, 2020.

Other services not listed will increase an average of 4.75%

If you have any questions regarding this increase, please contact Island Disposal Company, Inc. between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The Commission has the authority to set final rates that may be either lower or higher from the company's request, depending on the results of its investigation. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the Commissioners at an open meeting which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on May 21, 2020. The UTC building is closed to the public until further notice. This open meeting may be conducted by telephone only. If you intend to listen or participate, call 360-664-1234 for instructions the day before the open meeting.
