**NOTICE OF CONTINUANCE**  
**(Status Report Due by January 12, 2021)**

RE: *Frontier Communications Northwest, LLC, d/b/a Ziplly Fiber v. Kalama Telephone Company*, Docket UT-200751

TO ALL PARTIES:

On August 18, 2020, Frontier Communications Northwest, LLC, d/b/a Ziplly Fiber (Ziplly Fiber) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a formal complaint (Complaint) against Kalama Telephone Company (Kalama). In the Complaint, Ziplly Fiber alleges that Kalama has unlawfully encroached on Ziplly Fiber's service territory. Kalama subsequently counterclaimed that Ziplly Fiber has unlawfully encroached on Kalama's service territory.

The Commission conducted a virtual prehearing conference in this docket on October 13, 2020. During that prehearing conference, the parties requested a continuance of the proceedings for 90 days to enable their engineers to negotiate a resolution of the dispute.

The Commission finds the parties' request reasonable and will continue these proceedings pending the parties' negotiations. Ziplly Fiber and Kalama must report to the presiding administrative law judge on the status of those negotiations by January 12, 2021.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it continues the proceedings in this docket for 90 days. Ziplly Fiber and Kalama must report to the presiding administrative law judge on the status of the negotiations to resolve their dispute by January 12, 2021.**
