- **Operator Information Changes**—You are required to provide written notice within 30 days when starting or stopping operation of a public water system and to provide any updates to your contact information, such as address, email, phone numbers, etc. You can submit these updates on the [Waterworks Operator Information Form](#).
- **Your responsibilities as a Waterworks certified operator**—You are required to comply with all requirements listed in [WAC 246-292](#), but special attention should be paid to the “Duties” sections relevant to your Waterworks operator certifications. The sections covering the duties are listed as follows:
 - Duties of the Certified Operator in Responsible Charge ([WAC 246-292-032](#)).
 - Duties of a Cross-Connection Control Specialist (CCS) ([WAC 246-292-033](#)).
 - Duties of Backflow Assembly Tester (BAT) ([WAC 246-292-034](#)).
