As a PSE customer and a supporter of renewable energy, I fully endorse PSE's formal request for an extension of the existing net metering tariff.

PSE is diligently working alongside the solar industry and other stakeholders to assess the costs and advantages of customer-generated power for the grid. Their progressive approach, aimed at fairness and equity for all customers, deserves commendation.

I understand that Washington law sets a minimum requirement for net metering that every utility must adhere to. However, this minimum requirement does not restrict utilities like PSE from exceeding it. Despite not being obligated to change the current net metering tariff, PSE seeks formal approval to provide their customers with transparent information, empowering them to make informed decisions about investing in solar energy.

Granting approval to PSE's request will protect consumers and demonstrate the UTC's impartiality in evaluating utility tariffs.
