Enclosed for filing by Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (“PSE”) are three copies of Revisions Eight to Exhibit A of the special contract agreement between a predecessor company, Washington Natural Gas Company, and the Boeing Company (“Revision Eight”). The special contract agreement (the “Contract”) was approved by the Commission under the provisions of WAC 480-80-355 (now WAC 480-80-143) in Docket No. UG-950392.

Revision Eight does not make any significant changes to the Contract and is limited to making changes to Exhibit A to the Contract. Exhibit A lists the locations served under the Contract and the amount of firm and interruptible gas to be delivered to each location. The purpose of Revision Eight is to, as provided for in section 7 of the Contract, decrease the amount of Firm Agreement Demand at one location served under the Contract. Revision Eight also increases the projected interruptible volumes at the same location. This change was requested by Boeing on January 6, 2011, 60 days prior to the March 7, 2011 effective date as required by the Contract.

The attached Revision Eight contains customer specific information and, therefore, PSE requests that it be treated as “Confidential” and identifies the Boeing Company as the party that may be affected by disclosure of the information contained in Revisions Eight. In accordance with WAC 480-07-160, Revision Eight has been marked as “Confidential per WAC 480-07-160”. A redacted copy of Revision Eight is also enclosed.
