## RATE INCREASE NOTICE FOR THURSTON COUNTY BELOW 142<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE, RECYCLING, AND WASTE

Dear Customer:

July 30, 2021

Harold LeMay Enterprises, Inc. has filed a request for a rate change with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) to recover incremental COVID-19 costs incurred between March 2020 and February 2021. The Company incurred additional wages, supplies, and equipment costs due to hazardous working conditions experienced during this time. If this filing is approved by the WUTC, the COVID-19 cost recovery period will be September 1, 2021- August 31, 2023.

If approved, the proposed rates will become effective September 1, 2021. The rate per month will increase as follows:

Commission staff will make a recommendation to the Commissioners at an open meeting which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on August 26, 2021. The UTC building is closed to the public until further notice.
