## Re: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Docket TV-220466

Dear Mr. Moseley:

As you are aware, on December 8, 2022, the Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 02, classifying You Got It Movers as a household goods carrier, ordering the company to cease and desist, imposing a penalty, and holding the company in default for failing to appear at hearing. The Commission assessed a monetary penalty in the amount of \$10,000 for operating without first obtaining a permit from the Commission. On March 29, 2023, a Final Notice was sent to You Got It Movers in the amount of \$10,000, which was due on receipt. To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You will likely incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees and interest, which will be added to the outstanding \$10,000 balance.
