## TO ALL PARTIES:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 16 in Docket UE-100749, Rejecting Filed Revision to Schedule 95 and Authorizing Alternative Recovery of Over-Credits of Renewable Energy Credit Sale Proceeds (Order 16). It, among other things, requires Pacific Power & Light (Pacific Power or the Company) to make compliance report and true-up filings by May 1 of each year.

On May 2, 2016, Pacific Power filed its annual REC report. The Company included documentation about 2015 Renewable Energy Credit sales, the status of Schedule 95 rates, and proposes no changes to the currently effective Schedule 95 rate. The Commission has examined the filing, and it appears to comply with the terms of Order 16.
