On April 18, 2003, Qwest filed Advice No. 3397T, in compliance with the Commission's Thirty-Eighth, Fortieth and Forty-Ninth Supplemental Orders in Docket UT-003013. Qwest's filing was received on April 18, 2003, and due to the extreme length of the cost studies supporting the filing, they were provided only in electronic form. Commission Staff responsible for reviewing the filing received the electronic copy of the accompanying cost studies on April 21.
