designate certain common carriers as eligible telecommunications carriers (ETCs) so the carriers may receive federal universal service support funds. An ETC may request that the commission certify to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that the ETC is using federal support only for the intended purposes. The proposed rules delete the current rule that addresses certification to the FCC (WAC 480-120-399(2)). The proposed rules establish the requirements for designation as an ETC and create requirements for reporting and certification for those ETCs that request commission certification to the FCC that the ETC has used federal universal service support only for the intended purposes. The proposed rules will enable the commission to provide oversight of the use of federal universal service support funds.
