I understand that there are discussions going on between Integra and Qwest business executives, in which Integra asked many of the same non-legal questions. Warren Mickens will respond to those questions. I further understand that the retirement of CEMR and MEDIACC has been deferred by 450 days, or until all CLEC users have transferred to MTG, the new system. Finally, as to questions regarding paragraph 12 of the Integra merger settlement, those provisions have not been triggered.
