Attached are Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE's") replacement pages of its 2016-2017 Biennial Conservation Report's Attachment 2: The WA Department of Commerce EIA Report ("Attachment 2"), and Exhibit 1: 2016-2017 Savings and Expenses. The replacement Attachment 2 clarifies the Megawatt-Hour ("MWh") savings values used to calculate excess savings, and aligns with those calculation methods used by the other two Investor-Owned Utilities ("IOUs").

The replacement Exhibit 1 is a Microsoft Excel workbook that contains separate tabs, denoting:

1. The originally-reported 2016-2017 PSE electric conservation savings, noted in MWh,
2. Savings adjustments pertaining to applicable programs, and
3. The resultant, revised savings totals, by program.

The originally-filed Exhibit 1 contains language and a calculation on page 3 that duplicates the adjusted savings indicated on page 2 of the workbook, incorrectly inflating the final 2016-2017 savings total. The replacement Exhibit 1 corrects that error.

Please expunge the originally-filed Attachment 2 and Exhibit 1, and replace them with the attached updated Microsoft Excel files.
