**BACKGROUND**

- 1 On December 20, 2002, the Commission entered its Forty-Fourth Supplemental Order in this proceeding resolving issues on petitions for reconsideration. The Order directed Qwest to submit compliance filings on January 14, 2003. The Commission granted an extension of time for Qwest to file until January 21, 2003
  
- 2 Qwest, on January 21, 2003, filed Advice No. 3376T containing tariff revisions for its Tariff Nos. WN U-42 and WN U-43. On March 27, 2003, the Commission issued a Notice authorizing Qwest to amend its Part D compliance filing fifteen business days after approval of Qwest's Part B compliance filing. On May 15, 2003, the Commission issued its Fiftieth Supplemental Order approving Qwest's Part B compliance filing. On June 6, 2003, Qwest filed Replacement No. 1 to its Advice 3376T.

4 On June 9, 2003, Commission Staff filed comments on Replacement No. 1 to Advice 3376T. Staff stated it had reviewed the replacement advice, including the new sheet 27 that had been previously omitted due to an oversight, and that the compliance filing substantially complies with the Commission’s Forty-Fourth Supplemental Order.

5 The Commission finds that the tariff revisions filed with the Commission by Qwest on June 6, 2003 are consistent with the Commission’s Forty-Fourth Supplemental Order and therefore concludes that the substance of the tariff revisions should be approved as filed for effect on June 26, 2003.

**ORDER**

THE COMMISSION ORDERS That:

6 The tariff revisions refiled by Qwest on June 6, 2003, in accordance with the Forty-Fourth Supplemental Order in this proceeding, shall become effective as filed on June 26, 2003.

7 THE COMMISSION ORDERS FURTHER That it retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to effectuate the provisions of this and prior orders in these proceedings.
