On February 14, 2019, the Commission issued Order 01 in the above referenced docket denying an application for operating authority filed by Dolly, Inc. (Dolly). Dolly petitioned for reconsideration of that order on February 25, 2019.

Under WAC 480-07-850(1)(c), no party may file a response to a petition for reconsideration unless the Commission authorizes the response by notice. Staff asks the Commission to issue such a notice for the limited purpose of allowing Staff to file a short response to the petition. While Staff would like to respond to all of Dolly's arguments for reconsideration, it can limit its response to sections IV.B and IV.C of the petition if the Commission prefers. If authorized, Staff can file its response by Wednesday, March 13, 2019.
