Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, submits these comments in response to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's Notice of Opportunity to Comment on Requirement to File Annual Reports of Proceeds from Sale of Renewable Energy Credits issued on May 3, 2018.

Pacific Power has been submitting annual reports on May 1 of each year in compliance with Orders 6, 13, and 16 in Docket UE-100749 since 2013, and has projected no REC revenues since 2015. The company continues to forecast no REC revenues attributable to Washington customers in the near term. In light of these circumstances, Pacific Power appreciates the Commission's intent to relieve the company of this reporting requirement and minimize unnecessary filings.
