Q. By whom are you employed and in what capacity?

A. I am Manager, Pricing and Cost of Service for Puget Sound Energy, Inc.

Q. What are your duties as Manager, Pricing and Cost of Service?

A. As Manager, Pricing & Cost of Service, I am responsible for electric and gas rate
design, electric and gas cost of service studies and load research at PSE.

Q. Briefly describe your education and relevant employment experience.

A. I received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from Eastern Washington
State College in 1967 and a Master of Arts Degree in Economics from the
University of Washington in 1971. I continued in the University of Washington's
PhD program until 1974, completing all course work required.

Prior to joining PSE, I worked as an Economic Research Officer at Seattle-First
National Bank and as a Project Consultant with Boeing Computer Services in its

2 I began work for PSE as the Corporate Economist in November 1976. I have held
3 positions in corporate planning, market planning and forecasting, rate planning
4 and administration, commercial and industrial markets, and federal and state
5 regulation. In June 2006, I was named to my current position as Manager, Pricing
6 and Cost of Service. I have testified in state proceedings on forecasting, cost of
7 service, and rate design issues, in Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
8 proceedings on cost of service and rate design issues, and in Bonneville Power
9 Administration proceedings on a variety of rate making issues.
