The purpose of this letter is to report to the Commission consistent with the requirement of Paragraph 46 of Order 05, directing that the parties report back to the Commission how they wish to proceed.

The company has discussed this matter with Commission Staff. The company is extraordinarily disappointed with the outcome, but recognizes that the Commission has continuing questions about the Lakewood Pipeline Project. As a result, the company believes that the best method to proceed is to withdraw its filing as it relates to the Lakewood Pipeline Project, but not the portion of the filing related the General Facilities Charge which the Commission approved.


The company looks forward to discussing the alternative strategies for resolution as referenced in Paragraph 45 of Order 05, consistent with the Open Meetings Act. The company looks forward to explaining the benefits for the project, its thinking, and why the project is in the public interest in an informal setting that will allow the company to fully understand the Commission's concerns and how to address those concerns.
