3. The NWIGU is a nonprofit association comprised of 41 industrial end users of natural gas with major facilities in the states of Oregon, Washington, and Idaho. NWIGU members include diverse industrial interests, including food processing, pulp and paper, wood products, aluminum, steel, chemicals, electronics, and aerospace. The association provides an information service to its members and participates in various regulatory matters that affect member interests.

Counsel for NWIGU is authorized to intervene on behalf of NWIGU in this proceeding by NWIGU and its Executive Director.
